

## **Supplies for Mrs. Gloria Miller's English Class**

Students do better in school when they have the all the right supplies. Please purchase enough supplies to last the entire school year.

### **Bring the following supplies to class EVERY DAY:**

- 1) ONE 1½ three-ring binder **with FOUR dividers** (**Titles of dividers:** Current CW and HW, Dispatches, Notes, Corrected Work).
- 2) at least 100 sheets of college ruled loose-leaf notebook paper in your binder at all times. *Please do not use spiral notebooks or composition books in this English class.*
- 3) TWO pencils
- 4) TWO blue or black BALLPOINT pens for tests and final drafts
- 5) ONE red **and** ONE green BALLPOINT pen for correcting and color-coding essays
- 6) pencil pouch to keep everything in its place
- 7) small stapler with staples
- 8) personal bottle of hand-sanitizer

***\*\*Buy extra quantities of the above supplies so that you have enough for the ENTIRE school year.***

### **Printing:**

Students will be asked to print final and sometimes rough drafts. For this reason, it is important for students to have **a reliable printer**. Running out of paper or ink does not excuse an assignment from being counted as late. Late final drafts will have 10% of the score deducted and must be turned in within ONE school day of the original due date.
