

Ms. Altamira's Supply List 2024-2025 6th/7th English Honors

The following supplies must last the entire school year. If a student runs out of supplies or any of these supplies become lost or damaged, please replenish supplies as needed.

- 1 single-subject notebook
- 1 folder with two pockets (a binder used for multiple classes is acceptable; however, there must be one folder within the binder labeled and designated for English class ONLY)
- Reams of college-ruled paper (may be left at home, but please keep a sufficient stack in your folder/binder when attending class)
- Pencil case (preferably with a zipper)

- Regular Post-it packs (3x3)
- Small Post-it packs (1 3/8 x 1 7/8 OR 1 1/2 x 2)
- 3 Pencils
- Multiple eraser caps or one big eraser
- 3 Black pens
- 3 Blue pens
- 3 Red pens
- Highlighters (at least 3 different colors)
- Miniature stapler and staples

*It is important for students to have access to a working printer. Students will be asked to print drafts of their essays/academic work during various stages of the writing process. The printout counts as an assignment and will receive a zero if a student does not have a printed copy on the due date. We have printers available in our school library. It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to print required assignments BEFORE class.

Regular and small Post-its

- *Throughout one school year, pencils and tissue boxes are the most used/needed. (Majority of these donations are usually gone by the end of the first semester.)
- *Post-it easel pad posters are used for instruction *and* group projects. (This item is used quickly since there are usually only 30 sheets per pack.)
- *Colored markers, colored pencils, and glue sticks are used for in-class group projects. (One pack is given to each group.)
- *Student desks are disinfected with wipes weekly. (30+ desks in the classroom)
- *Ziploc bags are used for supplies and to preserve student novels.
- *All other wish list items are for student use.

Recommended Materials for 6/7 HGM Math:

- Scientific calculator (Texas Instrument ti-30xiis is what we will use in class any color)
- Mini stapler with staples
- Thin dry erase markers with eraser on the top
- Highlighters (thin highlighters are less bulky)
- Tape white-out (NO liquid white)
- Pencil pouch/box
- 1 folder with pockets (for graded papers titled "Math Graded Papers")
- 5 pencils (mechanical pencils need lead refills)
- A good big eraser
- 5 red pens for grading
- 100 sheets of lined paper college or wide rule your preference

Supplies for Science and Social Studies:

Scholars should bring to class every day:

- * Science Notebook or History Notebook (Both will be issued on the first day of school.)
- *Pencil pouch with pencils, blue or black pens, eraser, highlighter, mini stapler and staples, colored pencils (24 pack), pencil sharpener
- *Backpacks are not permitted in any of Ms. Kang's classes! If a locker is jammed or has ants, backpacks may be brought to class until the locker is suitable for use.
- * Use a tote bag for your science materials.
